


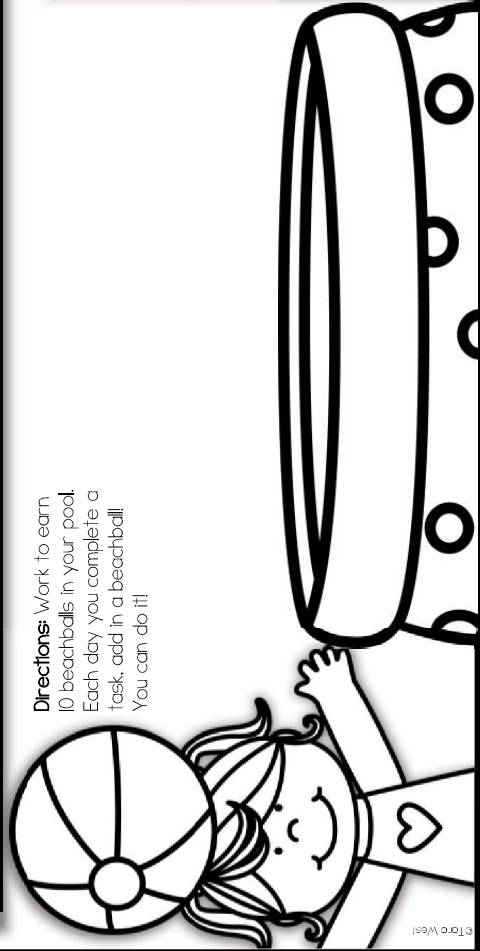
# June Learning Mat: Week 2

<b>Move-Your-Fingers Monday</b> Today you will be moving those fingers as you write numbers from 1-20. Guardian: Say a number to your child and have them write the number that comes next. Continue until all numbers from 1-20 have been written.	<b>Tap-N-Count Tuesday</b> Today you will be working on ordering numbers. Guardian: Give your child the following numbers and have them put them in order from least (smallest) to greatest (most). 38, 42, 40, 30	<b>Whip-Up-A-Web Wednesday</b> Today you will be making a "Compos to 10" web. Draw three circles. In the large circle, write the number 10. In the top circle, have your child draw 0 pictures. Have them solve what number is needed to make 10. 	<b>Think-It-Out Thursday</b> Today you will work on adding. Guardian: Say the following to your child and have them solve quickly to increase their fluency. 6+3 4+2 8+2 0+9	<b>Fast-N-Fluent Friday</b> Today you will work fast and fluently. Have your child count to 100 or higher.

<b>Move-Your-Fingers Monday</b> Today you will work on drawing a story. Have your child think about their story. Then have them draw a picture and label it. Ask them about two details of their story. Have them write at least two simple sentences about their story.	<b>Tap-N-Clap Tuesday</b> Today you will be working on sounding out words. Have your child stretch out the following words: nap bat rap big hog	<b>Whip-Up-A-Web Wednesday</b> Today you will be creating a web for words that end with a diagraph. Write "ch" in the middle of the web. Draw lines from the middle. On each line write a word or draw a picture of a word that ends with the "ch" sound. Some examples are couch, such, torch, etc.	<b>Think-It-Out Thursday</b> Today you will work on reading a text. Guardian: Have your child read an appropriate level text to you.	<b>Fast-N-Fluent Friday</b> Today you will work on sight word fluency. Use flash cards or a list to have your child read their sight words.
